The sophisticated Audyssey DSX circuitry works by synthesizing audio signals for new surround channels based on human perception and acoustical research. For optimum performance, Audyssey DSX controls delay, dynamic decorrelation, level and frequency response. The result is a much more realistic and “present” soundscape, with more audio “depth,” ideal for both movies and music. The new height and width channels are integral to maximum performance of next-generation high-definition surround-sound systems. DSX builds on the Audyssey MultEQ for room correction and Dynamic EQ for loudness compensation available in Denon receivers.
